<p>Description of Project and Services Provided:</p> <p>The development, called Kuala Lumpur Sentral, a new landmark in the heart of Kuala Lumpur, will be built on the existing Keretapi Tanah Melayu Berhad (KTMB) yard. Once it is completed, the project would transform the present neglected marshalling yards at Brickfields into a dynamic new central business district for Kuala Lumpur, converting it into a "city-within-a-city"</p> <p>This project is a joint venture between Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB) and KTM Berhad. MRCB was awarded the privatisation contract to construct the integrated transportation hub in exchange for the rights to develop KTMB's 72 acre yard in Brickfields into an integrated commercial development centre.
